- The cost of living in Germany for foreign students:

640 €/month, including:

- ≈ 200 Euro fee for the hostel;
- ≈ 70 € – mandatory medical insurance;
- ≈ 370 euros for everyday expenses.

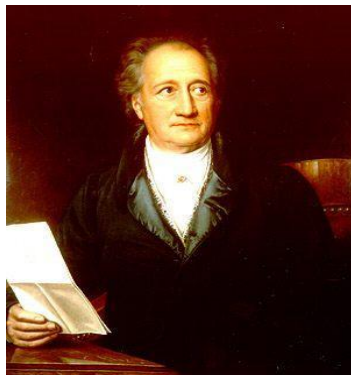
