What do they usually do in summer?

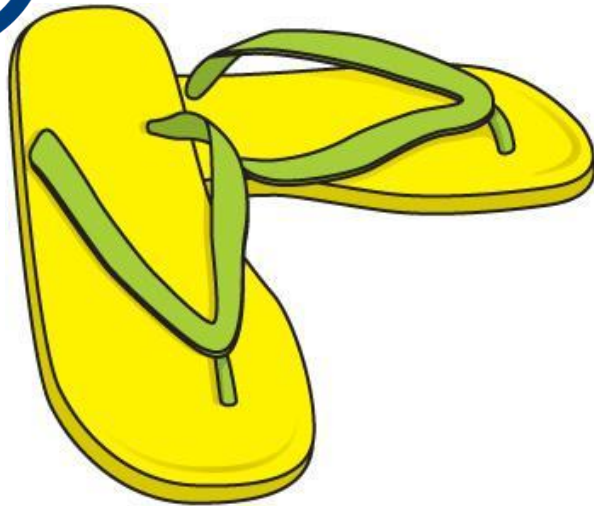


What don't they do in winter?

What do they usually do in summer?



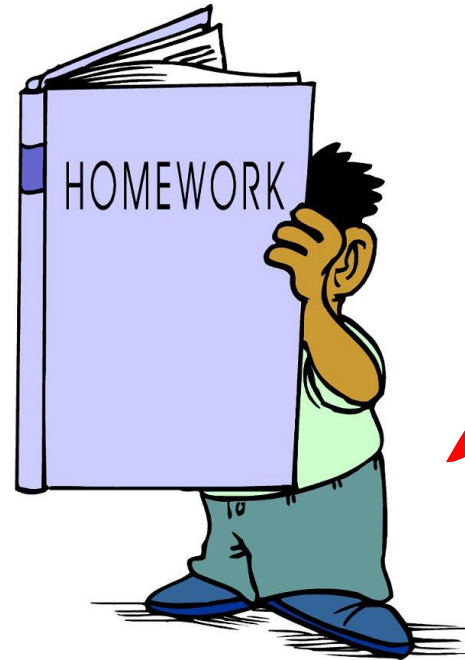
What don't they do in winter?

Ex: I am 12 years old. / Cats like milk.



Habitual actions or routines

Ex: Richard gets up early every day.

Timetables

Ex: Classes start next week.



Permanent situations

Ex: She works in London.
