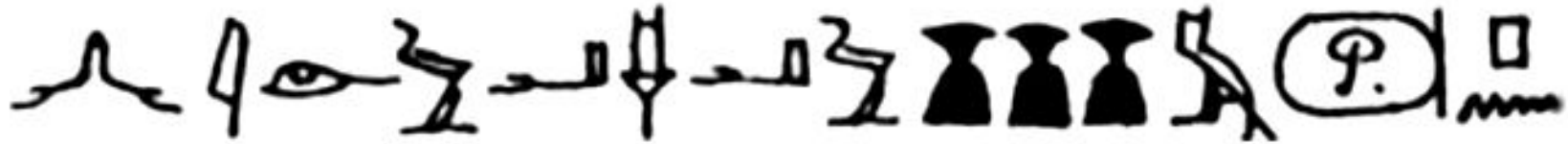

against this Pepi"

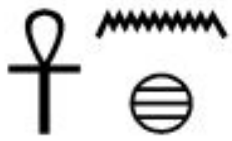


