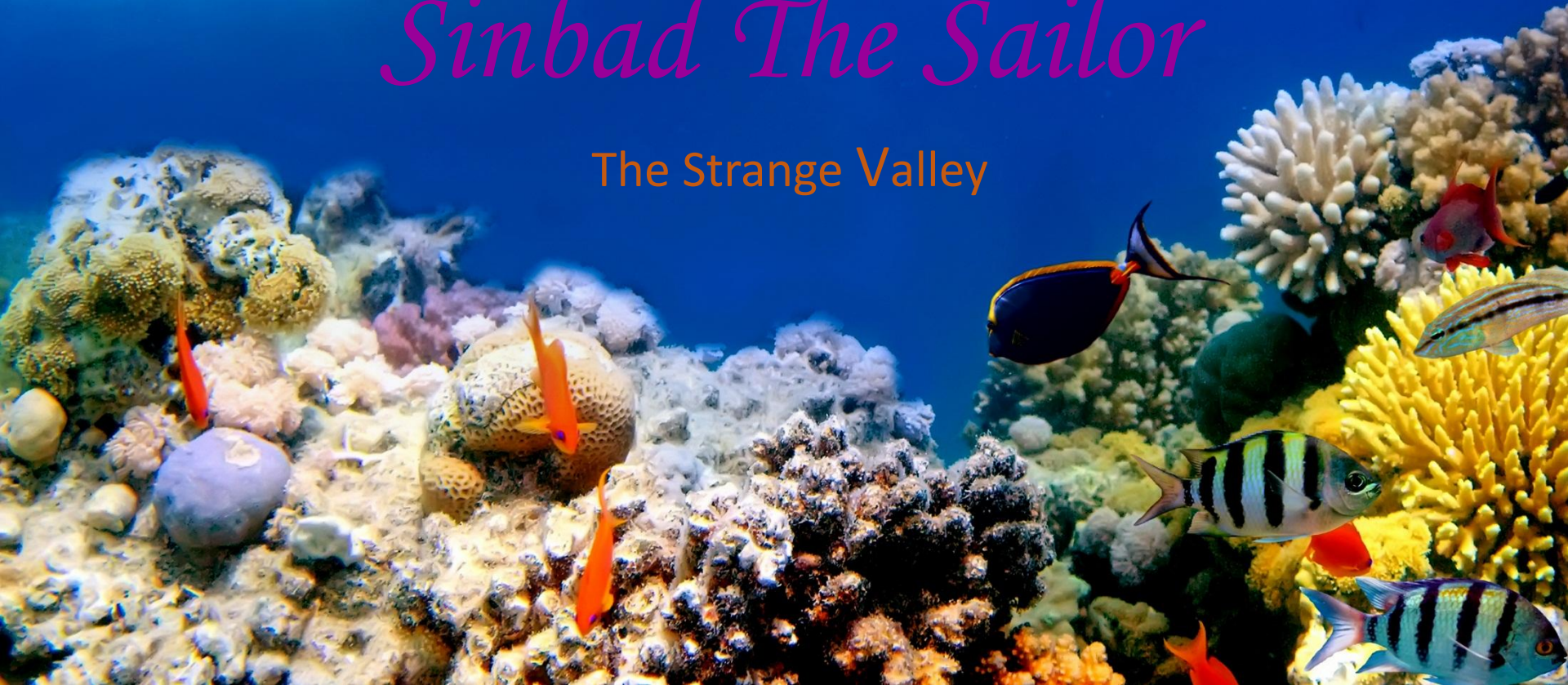




Sinbad The Sailor
