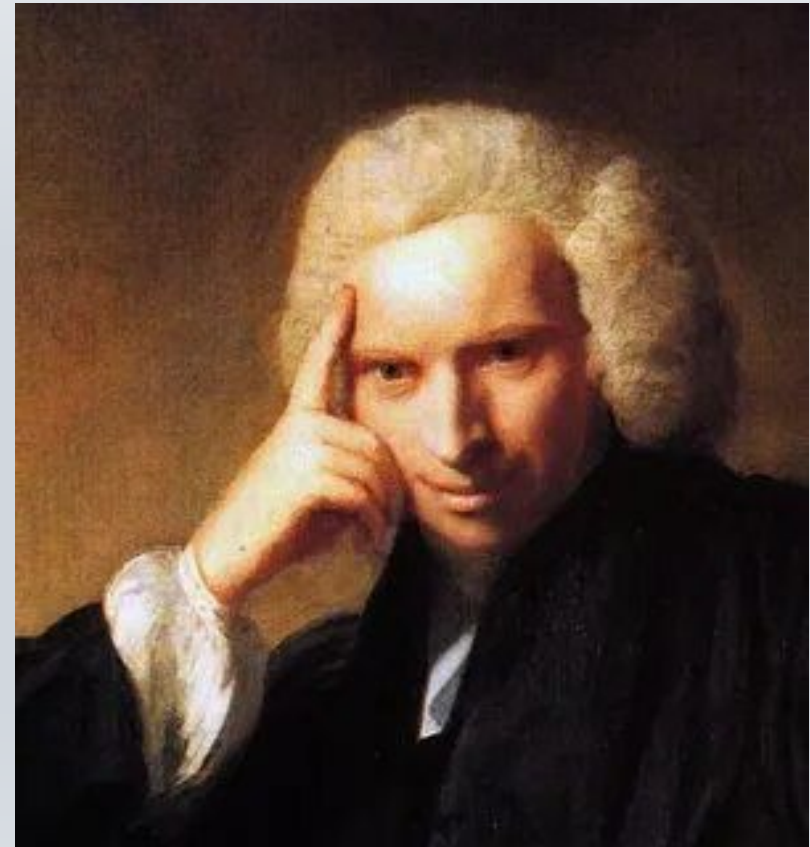




# Before I tell you about my hobbies, I will tell you the history of the hobby...

---

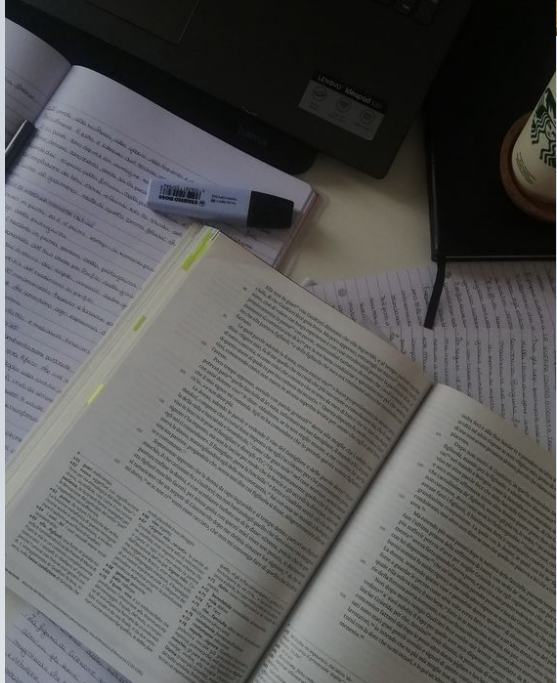
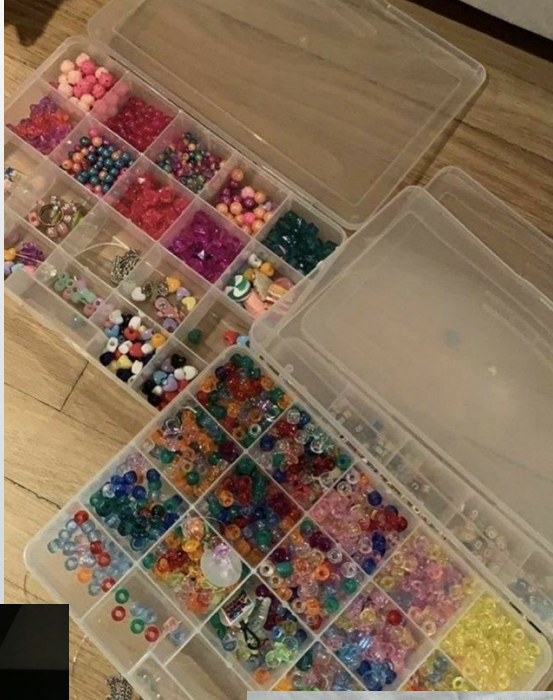
