# Mansion (p.162)



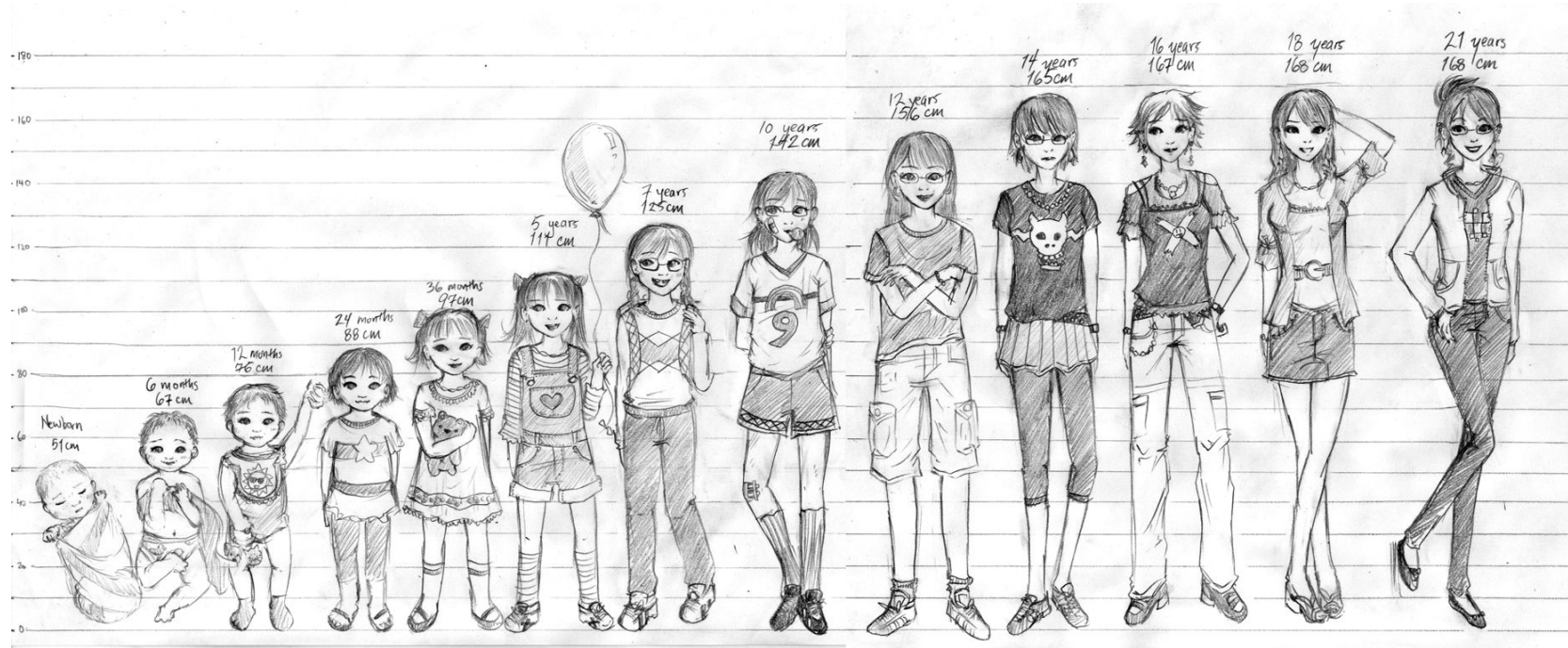
- a very large, expensive house.
