


How to install the Windows 8.1 on DOS version E10-30

I. Configure in the BIOS setup

Configure in the BIOS setup


Step1: Power on your computer and press Fn+F2 enter BIOS setup, Locate “Exit” page, change “OS Optimized Defaults” from “Other OS” to “Win8 64bit” as picture 1-1.

Configure in the BIOS setup (Continue)


Step2: Press Fn+F9 load default as picture 1-2.

Step3: Press Fn+F10 saving changes and exit as picture 1-3.




Picture 1-3 Save and exit

II. Install Windows 8.1

Install Windows 8.1

Plug USB CD/DVD-ROM with Windows 8.1 disk, power on your computer and press Fn+F12, select boot from USB CD/DVD-ROM as picture 1-4, and then start to Windows install.
