

  - situations and states that started in the past and are still true\*,
  - a series of actions continuing up to now\*.
- 4. Already, never, ever, yet, for

Have you ever flown a helicopter?
I've lost my keys.

She's had her motorbike for over six years.

We've travelled by taxi, bus, plain and train – all in the last 24 hours!





Has she called him?

What have you done?

Have+not=haven't

I have not done anything wrong.

She hasn't called me yet.

I have been waiting here for 1 hour!

I'm out of breath because I have been running to get here in time.

Sometimes there is a very little difference between the Present Perfect
 Simple and the Present Perfect Continuous.

I <u>have worked</u> at the airport for four years=
I <u>have been working</u> at the airport for four years.

I <u>have read</u> that book about castles (I have finished it)
BUT

I <u>have been reading</u> that book about castles (I have not finished it yet)

Have + subject + been + Ving

Have you been cooking since afternoon?

Has she been working in the garden for 3 hours?

Have + not + been + Ving

It hasn't been snowing here since 2003.

- By the time, after + past perfect, past perfect+before
  I had already finished washing dish by the time she came home.
  After I had done my homework, I went to my friend's place.

• (Вопросит. Слово)+Had+подлежащее+V3

Had you finished watching TV before she came home?

Why had you told it to her before she left?

Had+not+V3

I looked around. She hadn't touch anything.

She hadn't seen him before she met.

- The action will have been finished by a certain time in the future.
- Ву (к какому-либо времени)

I will have come home by 7 o'clock.

He will have finished cooking by the time she comes home.

Will+подлеж.+have+V3

Will you have done your homework by 5 tomorrow?

Will+not+have+V3

He will not have his homework done by 6 tomorrow.

# Future Perfect Continuous

- 1. Будущее завершенное длительное.
- 2. Will+have+been+Ving
- 3. The action in progress up to a point in the future.

At seven o'clock l'<u>II have been doing</u> my homework for three hours!

Will+subject+have+been+Ving

I heard you were going to retire soon. For how many years <u>will you have bee</u> <u>working</u> here by that time?

Will+not+have+been+Ving

I will not have been doing my homework for 2 hours at 7 o'clock.
