

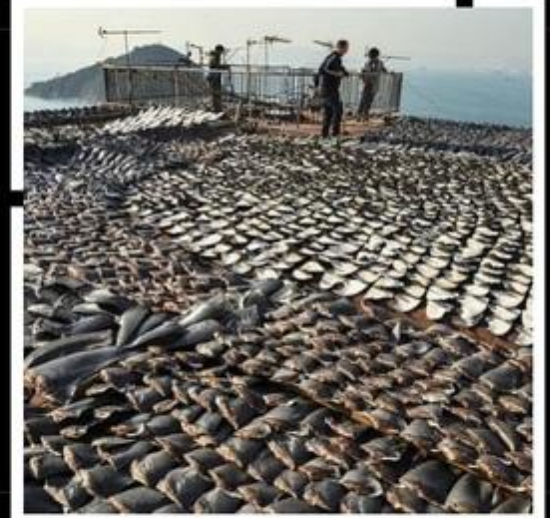

# *The reasons for poaching: money, food, religion*

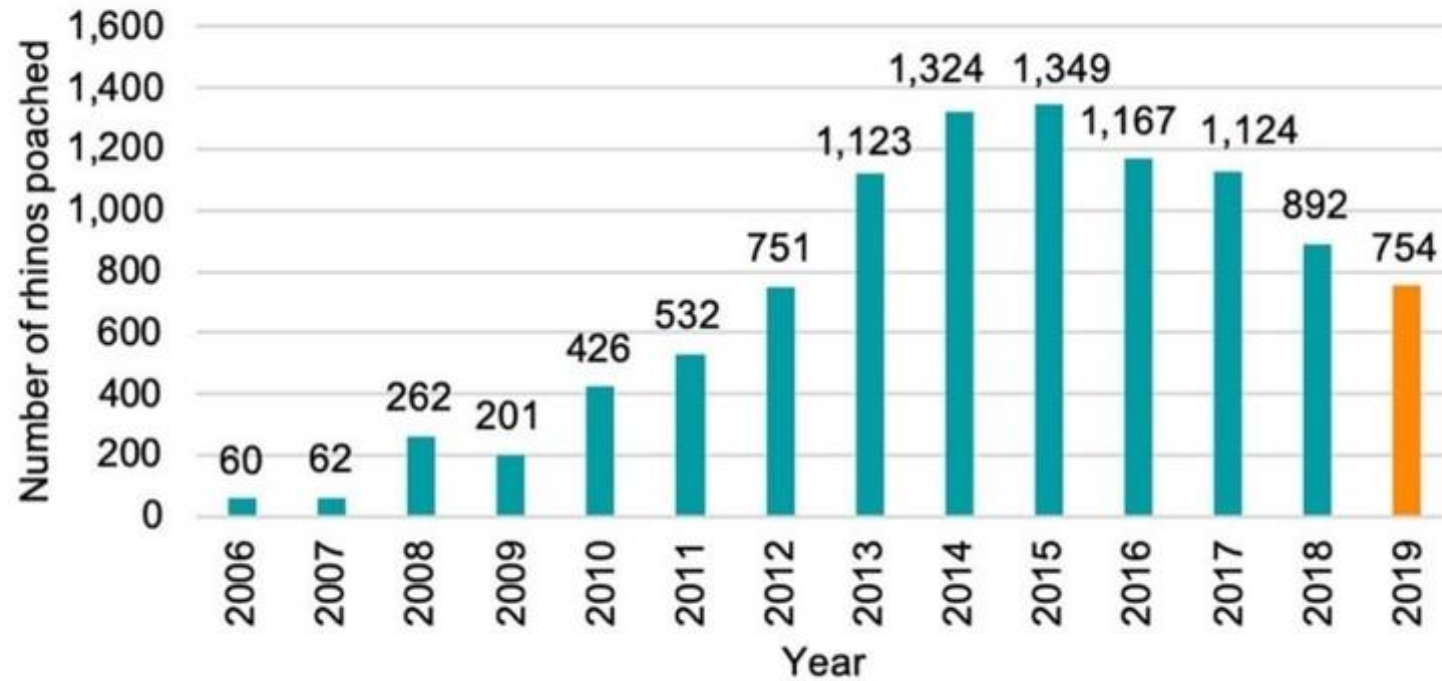


- 1) The pangolin - for their meat and their scales

# *Hunting ≈ Poaching*

**Hunting is poaching when:**

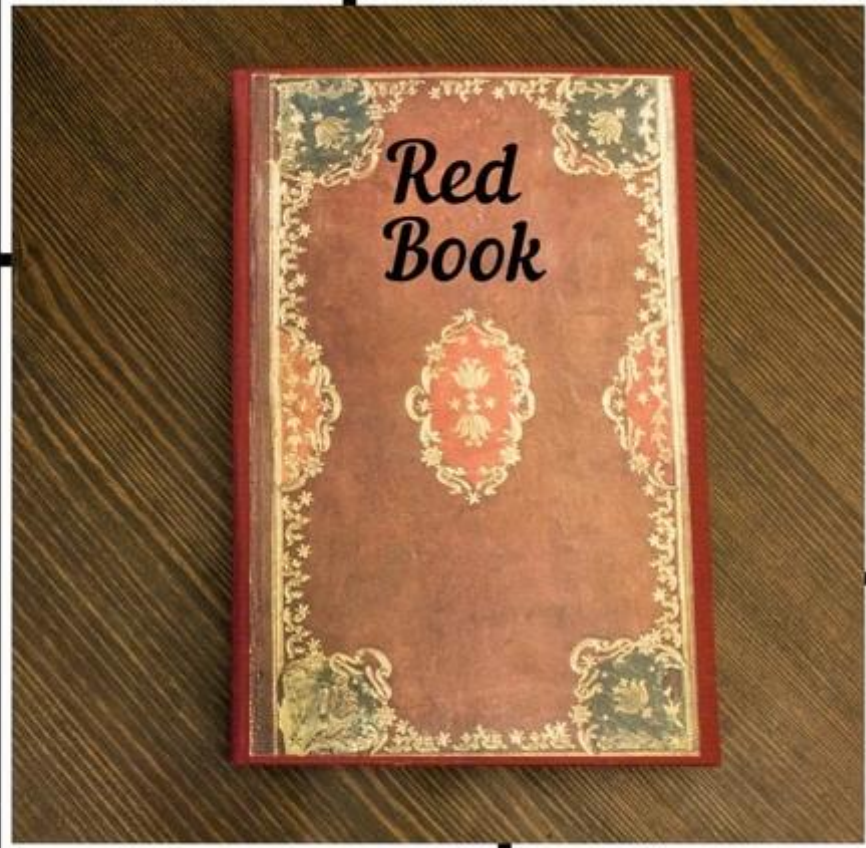
- Hunting during the period of reproduction
- No license
- Using weapons and pyrotechnics
- Using any means of transport
- Hunting in nature reserves
- Corringing species to rare or endangered species



# *The Red Book*

The first international edition of the Red Book was published in 1963. Its authors worked on the book for about 15 years.

All animals and plants in the Red Book are assigned levels from 0 to 5:  
0- the species is completely gone  
5- the population is recovering.





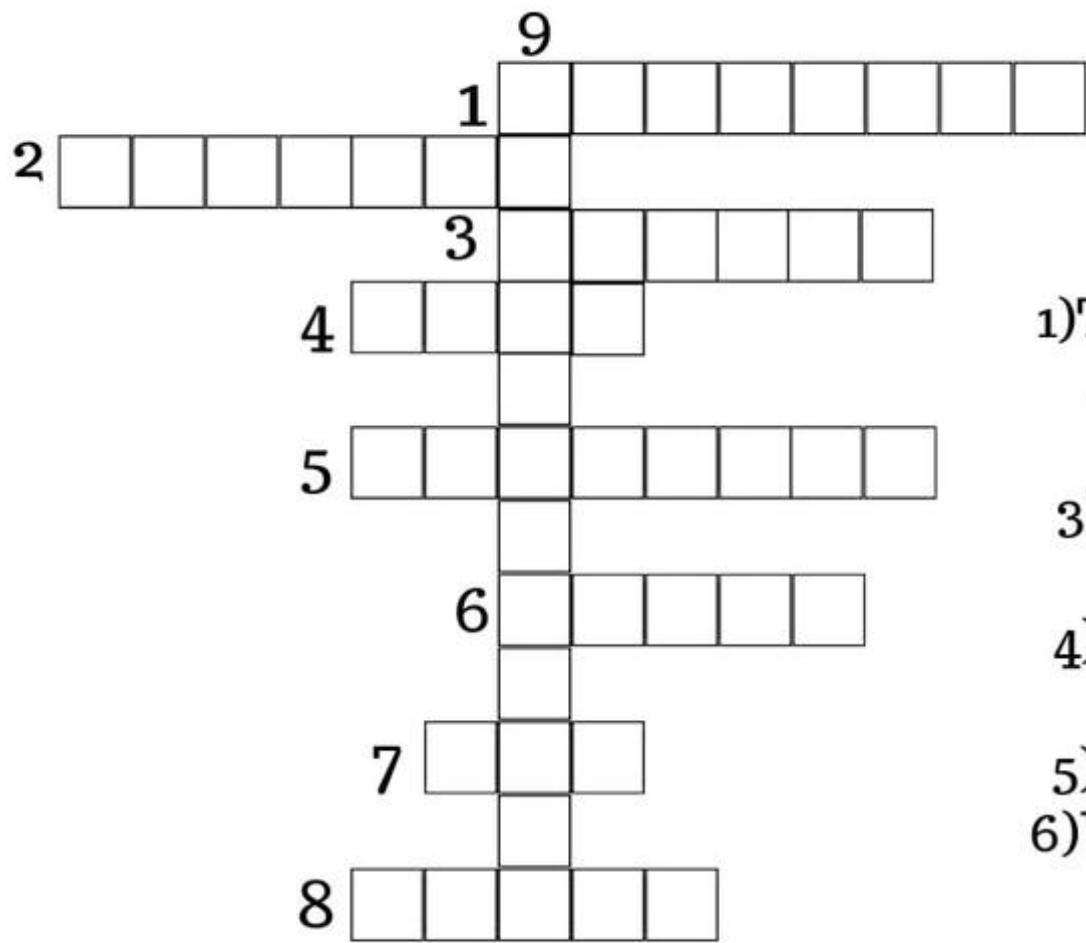
