



ADMINISTRATIVE CASE STUDY: COMBINED ESL PROGRAMS

1) Intensive English

- Started with: "off-the-shelf" curriculum
- Developed our own <u>individualized</u> curriculum
- · Learners are individualized, not "one-size-fits-all"


2) Phonetics

- Started with: "deficit model" [student language is broken, we need to fix it]
- Developed <u>strengths-based</u> communication model

3) Composition

- Started with: grammar-based approach
- Developed <u>flipped</u> classroom model



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

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THE PERFORMED CULTURE APPROACH TO 21ST C. LANGUAGE LEARNING

1) LANGUAGE <u>CANNOT BE SEPARATED</u> FROM THE CULTURAL CONTEXT IN WHICH IT OCCURS.

2) IN LEARNING A FOREIGN LANGUAGE, WE ARE ACTUALLY LEARNING A FOREIGN CULTURE. WE ARE NOT LEARNING A LANGUAGE—WE ARE LEARNING TO DO THINGS IN THAT LANGUAGE IN A **TARGET CULTURE**. MERE LANGUAGE WON'T HELP US COMMUNICATE EFFECTIVELY.



PERFORMED CULTURE APPROACH WHAT ARE THE GOALS?

- 1) Grammar-Oriented to Communication-Oriented
- 2) Textbook-Oriented to Multimedia-Oriented
- 3) Exam-Oriented to Performance-Oriented

THE MOST BASIC PERFORMANCE: GREETINGS (TEXTBOOK VS. REAL)

A: Hi, how are you?

B: I'm fine thanks, and you?

A: I'm fine too. Nice to meet you.

B: Nice to meet you too.

How ya doin'?

What are you up to?

What's up?

What's goin' on?

How's it goin'?

HOW TO LEARN PERFORMANCES:

Online Informal Learning of English

Definition: The opposite of formal classroom learning of English

Online = anything utilizing the internet

Informal = recreational, leisure-time activities

Learning = anything which improves your proficiency

CASE STUDY--FRANCE

Every 6 years the Ministry of Education surveys 5000 teenagers

Usually there might be 1-2 point gains in English proficiency

In 2016, there was an increase of **16 points**
