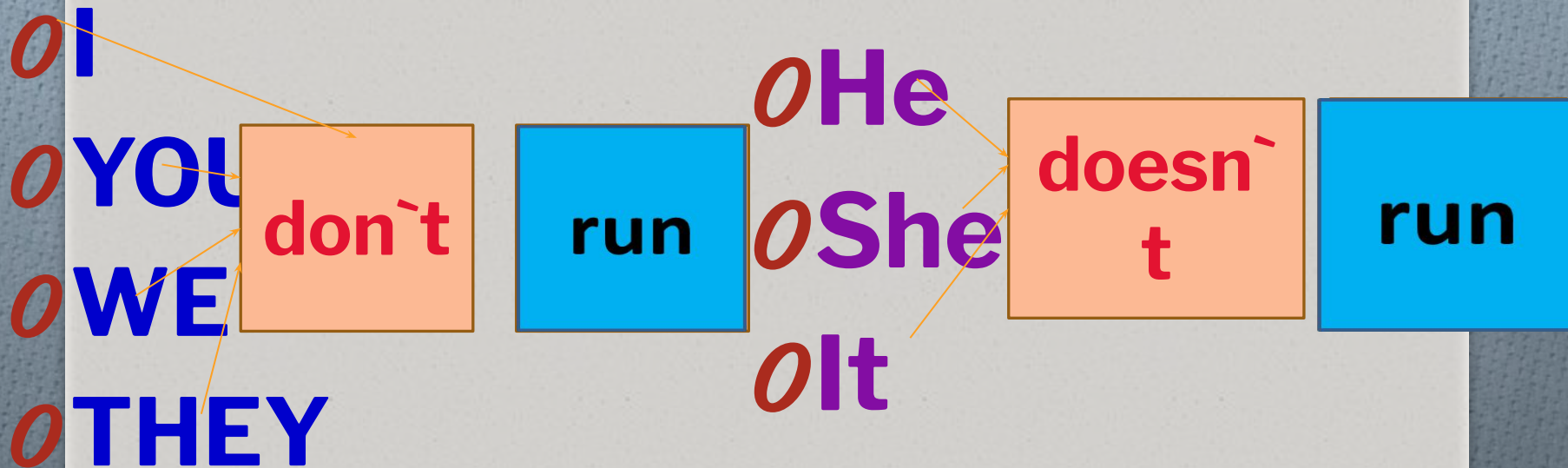

walk • bite • hide • sing

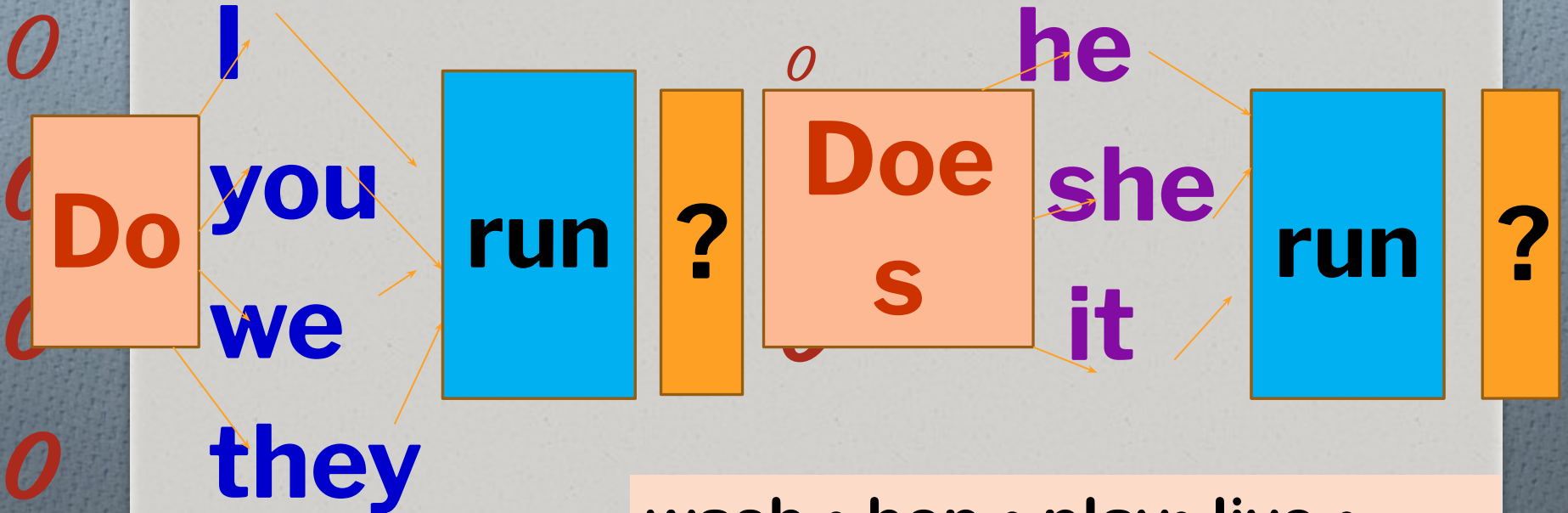


# Present Simple (negatives)

# Present Simple (questions)



wash • hop • play • live •  
miss • like • carry • climb •  
talk • cry • work • drive •  
hide • sing



**Affirmative****Negative****Interrogative**

**Long form**  
 I do not like  
 You do not like  
 He does not like  
 She does not like  
 It does not like  
 We do not like  
 You do not like  
 They do not like

**Short form**  
 I don't like  
 You don't like  
 He doesn't like  
 She doesn't like  
 It doesn't like  
 We don't like  
 You don't like  
 They don't like

Do I like?

 Does it like?  
 Do we like?  
 Do you like?  
 Do they like?

**We use Simple Present for permanent or habitual actions. happening now.**

**Short answers**

Do you like apples?

Yes, I do.  
 No, I don't.

it

 like apples?

Yes, 

he
she
it

 does.  
 No, 

he
she
it

 doesn't.

Do they sleep?

Yes, they do.  
 No, they don't.

**Spelling: 3rd person singular**

**verbs ending in:**

**ss, sh, ch, x, o** → **+ es**

I dress - he dresses

I go - he goes

**consonant + y** → **ies**

I try - he tries

**BUT**

I play - he plays

*o* 8.30 - eight thirty

*o* 9.30 - nine thirty

*o* 2.30 - two thirty
