Combinations of plosive and
fricative consonants

- Fricative consonant – фрикативный согласный
- Adjacent consonants – смежные согласные
- Coarticulation – взаимная артикуляция

Fricative Plosion

- Upside - when a plosive consonant [p] precedes a fricative consonant [s] in a word or at a junction of words a plosive consonant [p] has its release during the pronunciation of the fricative consonant [s]. This phenomenon is called fricative plosion.

Regressive assimilation affecting the place of articulation

Alveolar consonants before [ǰ,θ]

- Alveolar consonants – альвеолярные согласные,
- Interdental consonants – интердентальные согласные,
- Dental variants - дентальные варианты,
- Allophones - аллофоны.

- Alveolar consonants – [t, d, n, l, s, z],
- Interdental consonants – [θ, ð].

Ninth – at the junction of the alveolar consonant [n] and the interdental consonant [θ] regressive assimilation affecting the place of articulation takes place: the alveolar consonant [n] is represented by the dental variant.

Combinations of consonants with [w]

Combinations of consonants with [w]

a stressed syllable – ударный слог,

lip-rounded (labialized) – округленный

Double assimilation of consonants [t, k, s] with [w]

twenty – when the sonant [w] is preceded by a voiceless consonant [t] there is the devoicing of the sonant [w] (progressive assimilation affecting the work of the vocal cords takes place) and a voiceless consonant [t] is lip-rounded under the influence of the sonant [w] (regressive assimilation affecting the place of lips takes place). Thus, in the cluster [tw] double assimilation takes place.

Double assimilation takes place in the clusters [sw, kw].
Sweep, quiet.

Regressive assimilation affecting the place of lips

Dweller – the consonant [d] preceding [w] is lip-rounded, it means that regressive assimilation affecting the place of lips takes place.
