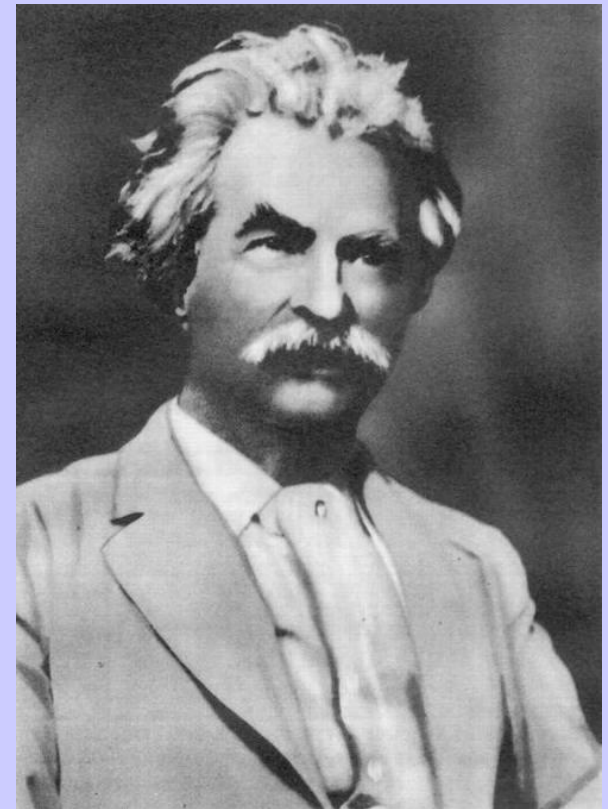

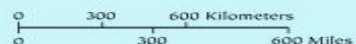

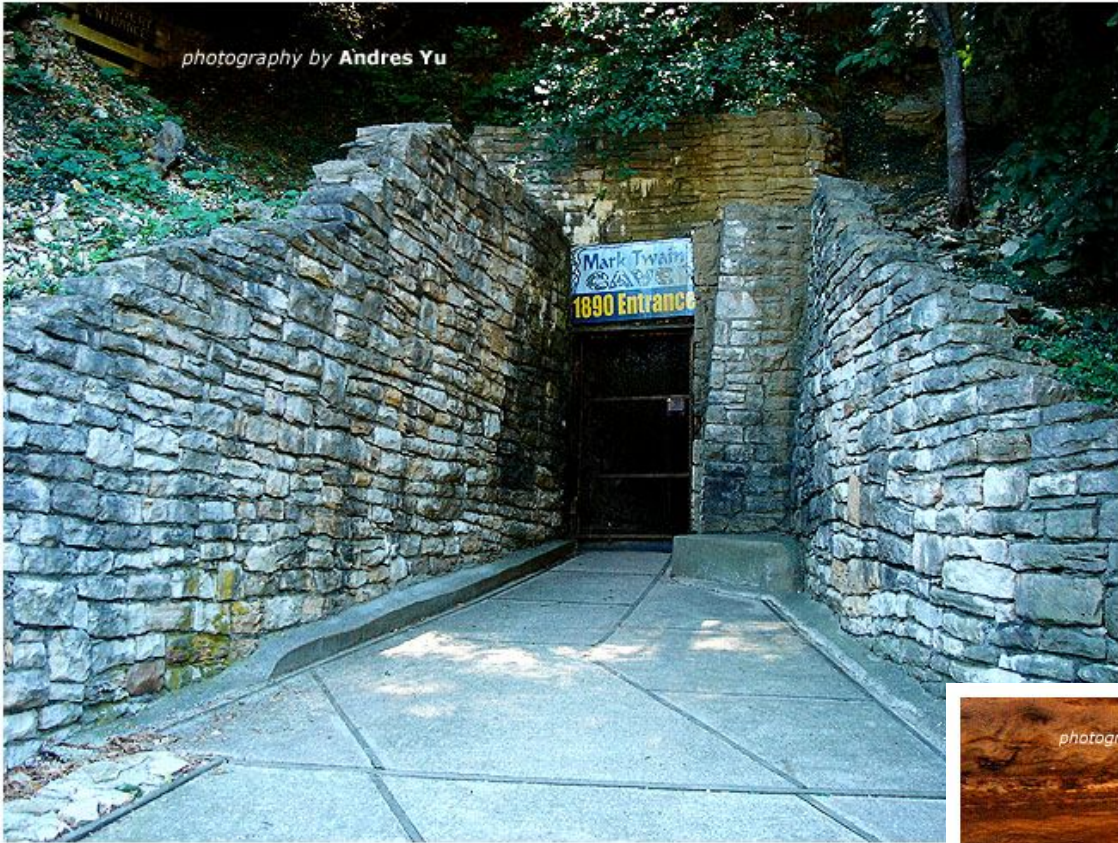

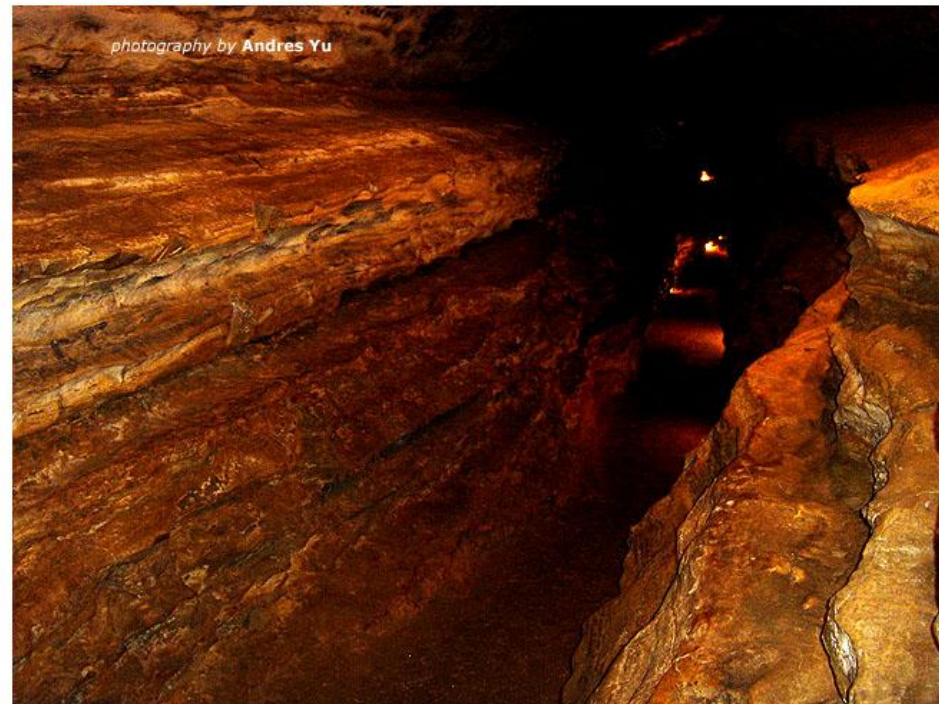
Mark Twain Monument, Riverview Park, Hannibal, Mo.
