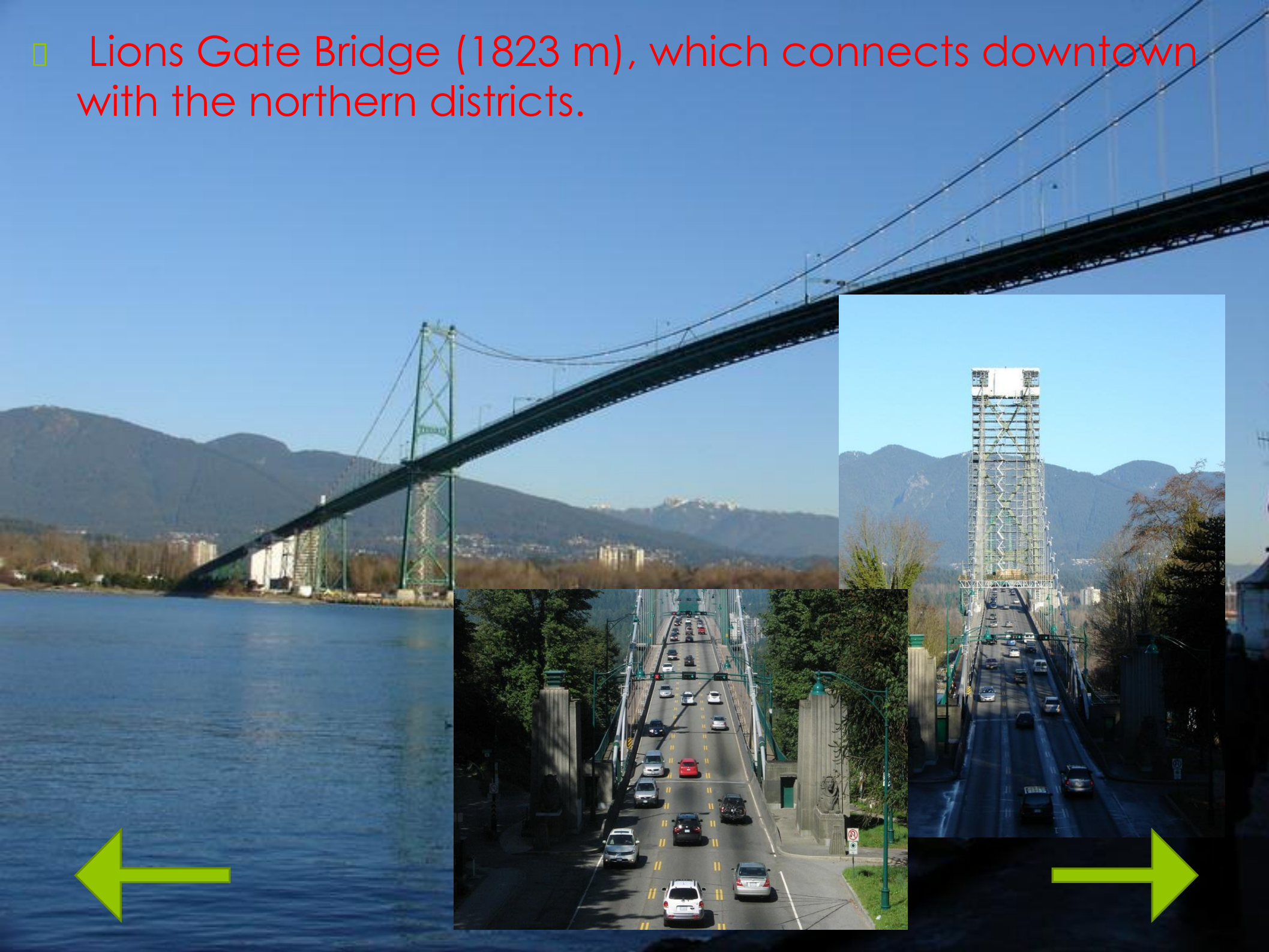
- Vancouver is one of the largest industrial centers and the largest port in western Canada.

□ Considered to be the most popular Stanley Park, founded in 1886.



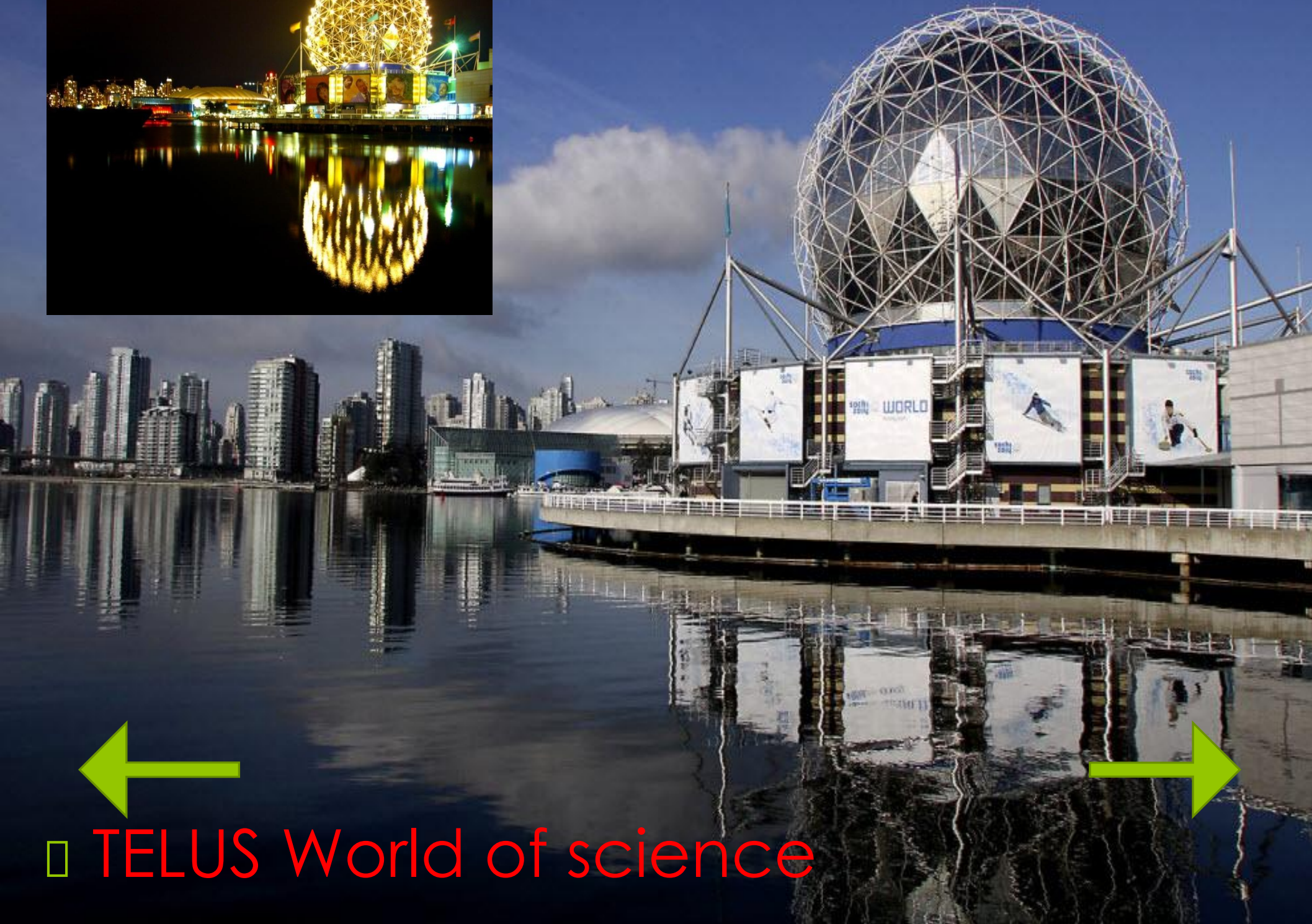

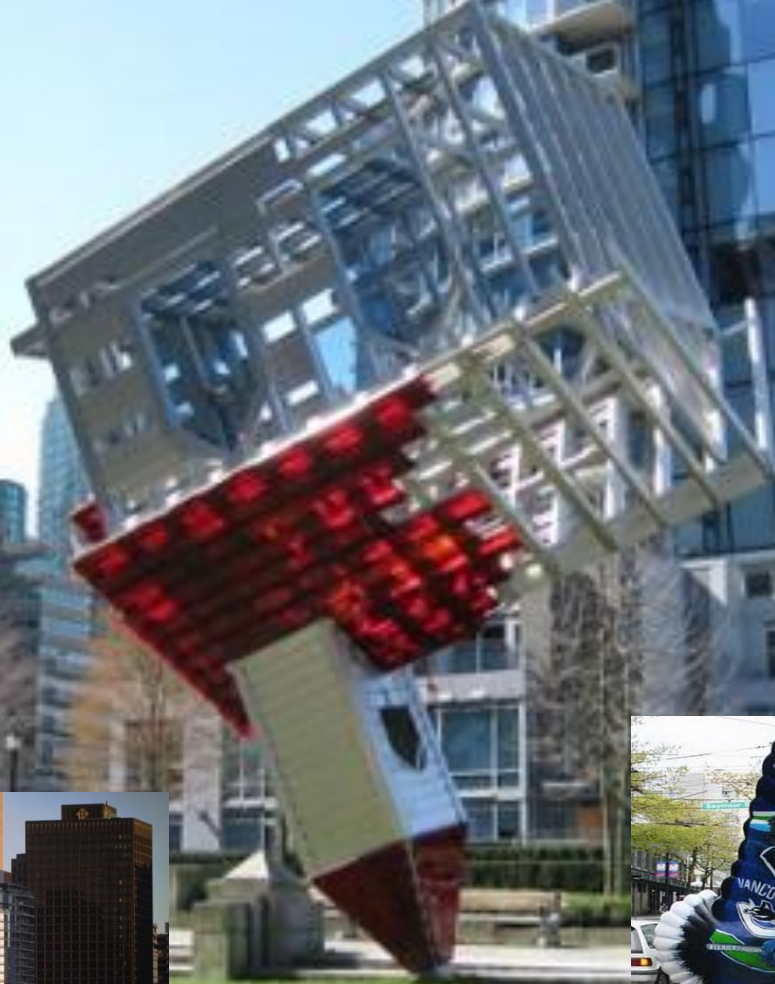


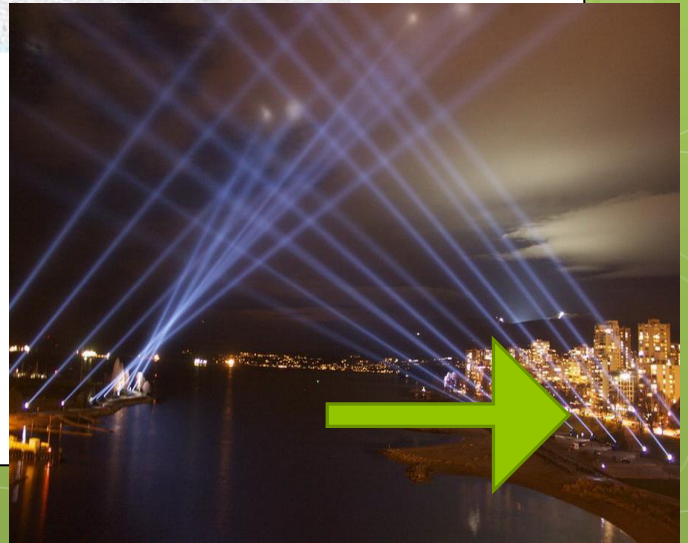
