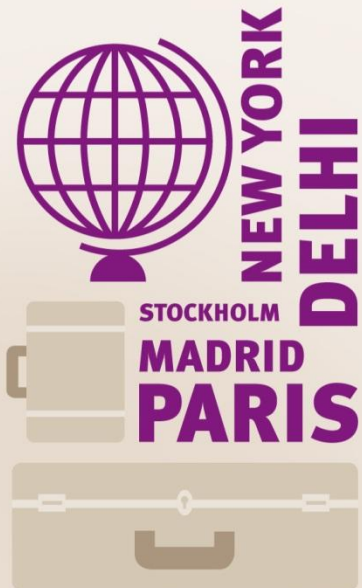

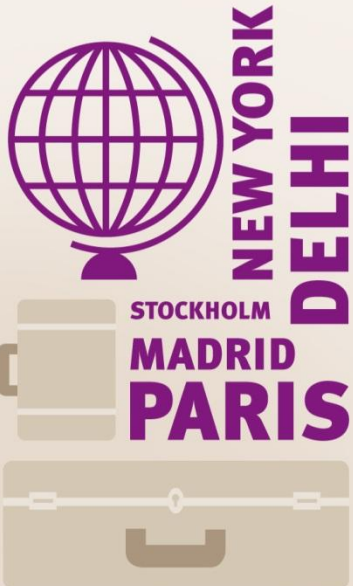

Main information



- Italy was unified in 1861 and became a Republic in 1946
- The population is about 60 million
- The surface is 301,338 km²
- It is divided in 20 regions
- Italy hosts 2 foreign countries, the Republic of S.Marino and Vatican City.
- The capital and largest city is Rome
- More than 75% of Italy is hilly or mountainous.
- Italy is the fourth most visited country in the world, with about 5 million visitors annually.
- About 85% of Italians are Roman Catholic.
- The average Italian eats about 30 kg of pasta per year and drinks 98 liters of wine.
- The climate is Mediterranean with hot, dry summers and mild, rainy



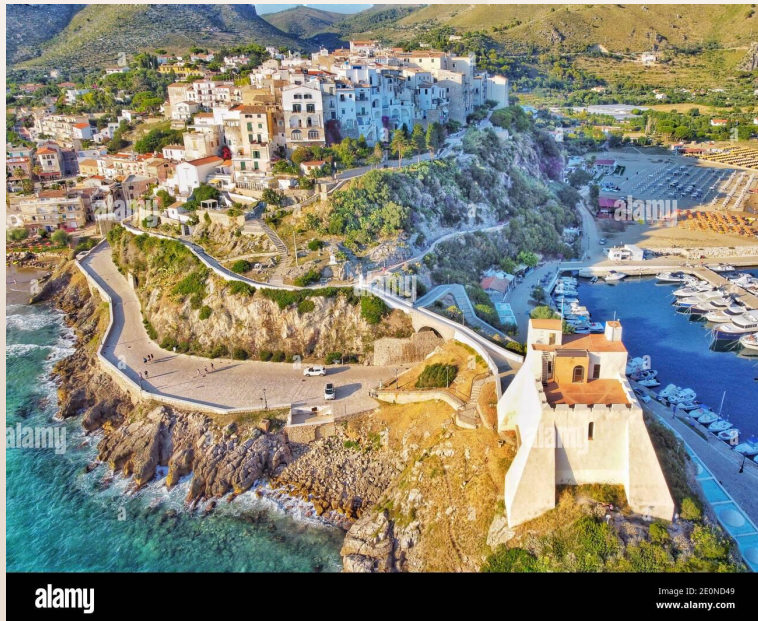

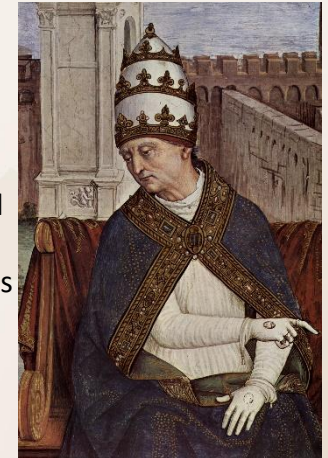

Caribbean in 1492.



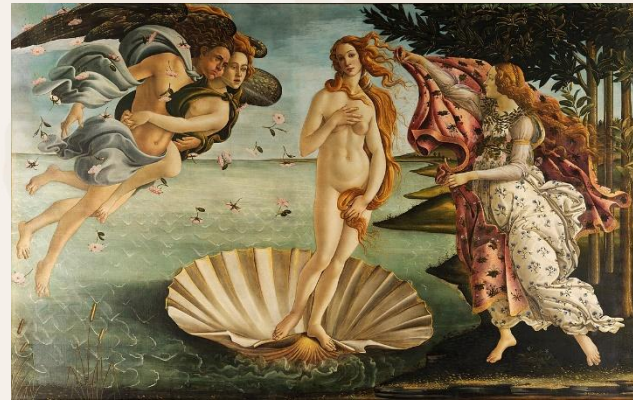
Pio II Piccolomini

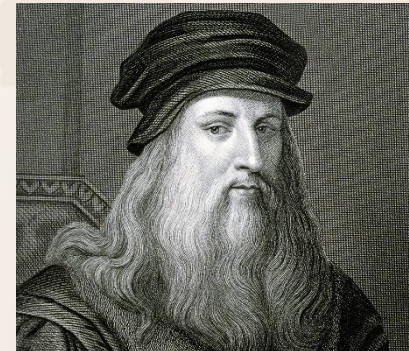


Raffaello

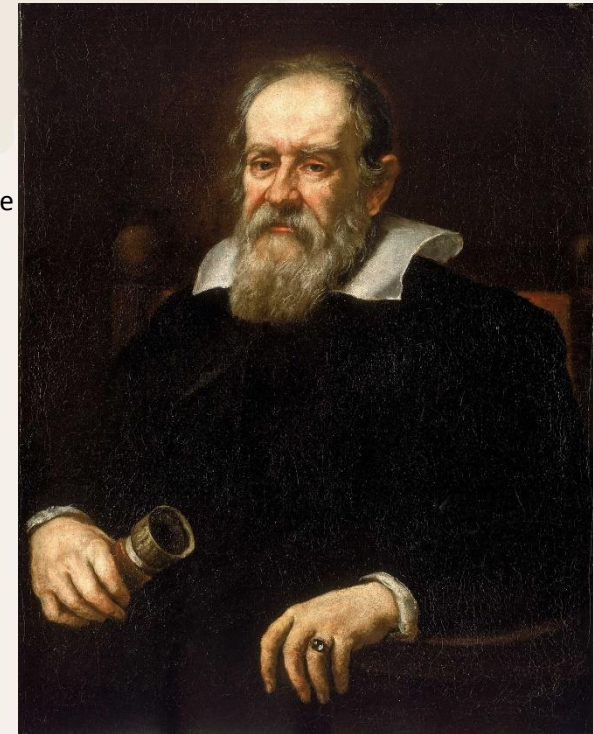
Sciences
