



Arise/v= begin to happen Bed/v= to move part of your body so it's not straight Blow/v=to send air out from your mouth OR if the wind or a current of air blows, it moves Broadcast/v= to send out radio or television programs Burst/v= explode Deal with = handle deal in something to be interested or involved in something/to buy and sell a particular type of product Dig= to move earth, snow etc, or to make a hole

Sow= to plant or scatter seeds on a piece of ground


Spill= pour
