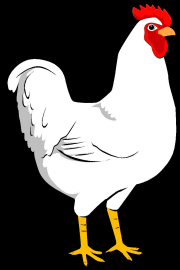
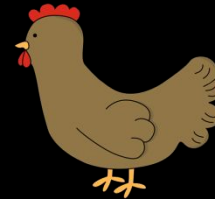

Our Feathered Friends



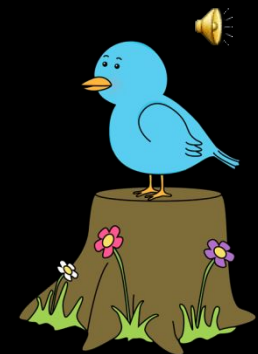
My math test was **duck

duck!

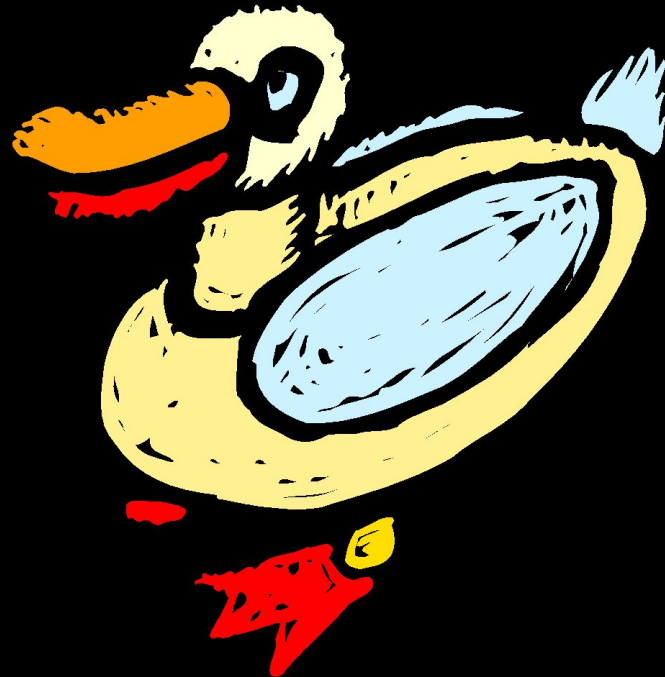
Boy, are you in trouble!

You know why? I just won 3 million dollars in the lottery- that's why.



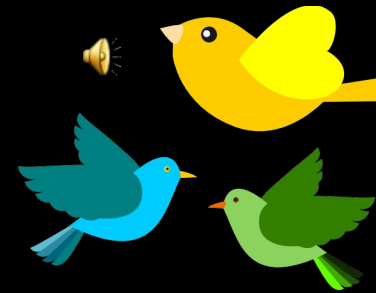
Next week I'll be free as a  bird!

When he won an Olympic medal in the 100 meters, his father was thrilled.



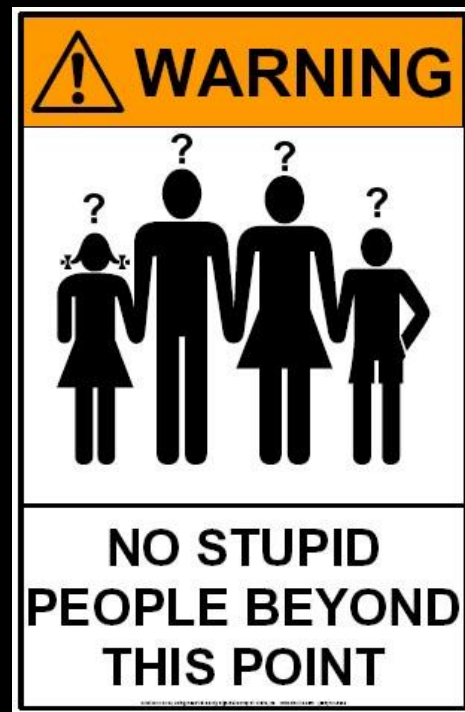
A bird in the hand is worth two in the bush.

What a **bird brain**  he is!

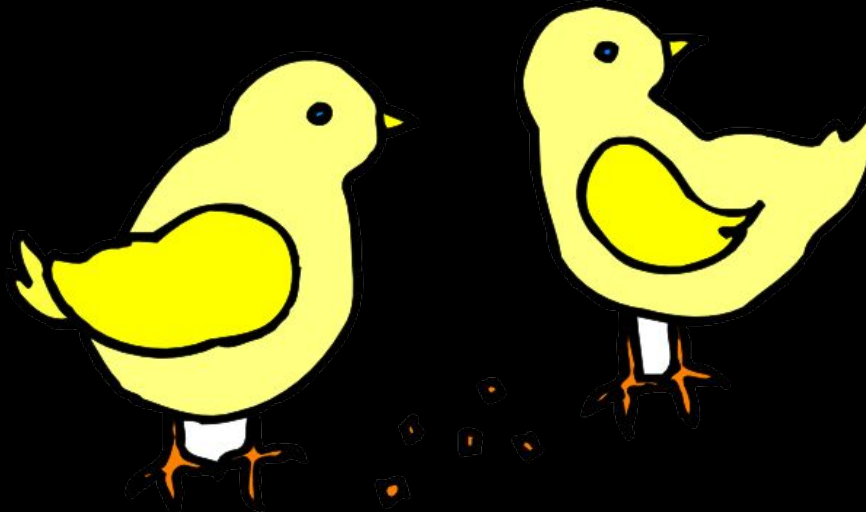
He's the stupidest person I have ever known.



*That jobs pays **chicken feed**.*

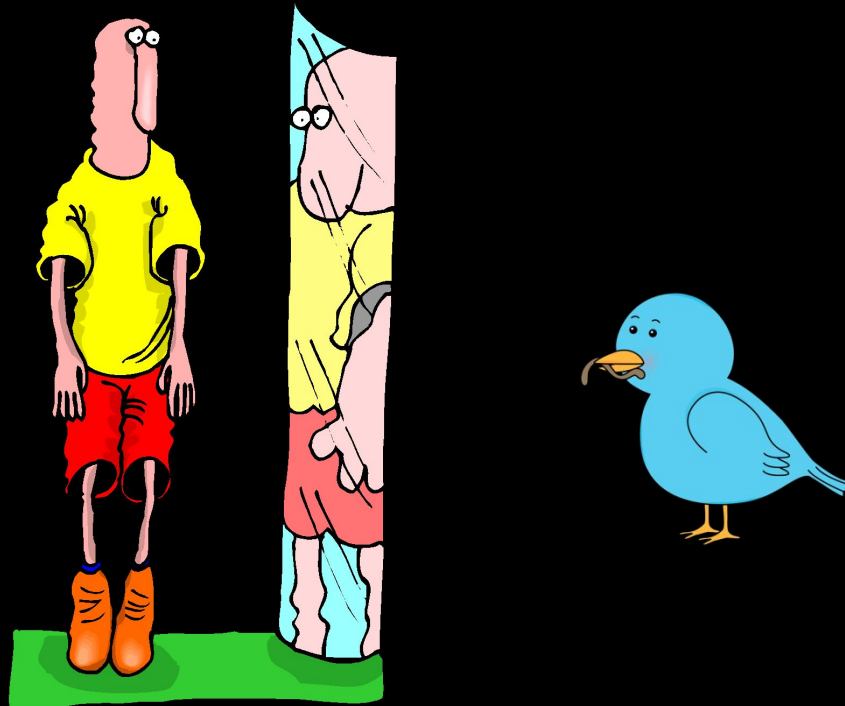


Why would anyone take a job like that - for so little money?! You must be nuts!

a bird!

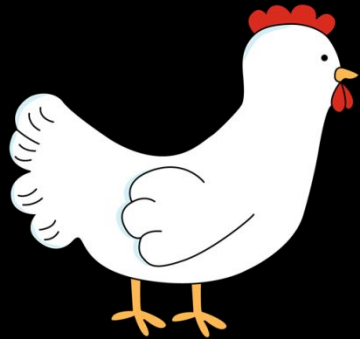
No wonder he is so skinny!

He stays up all night playing computer games.



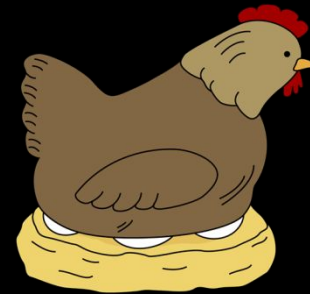
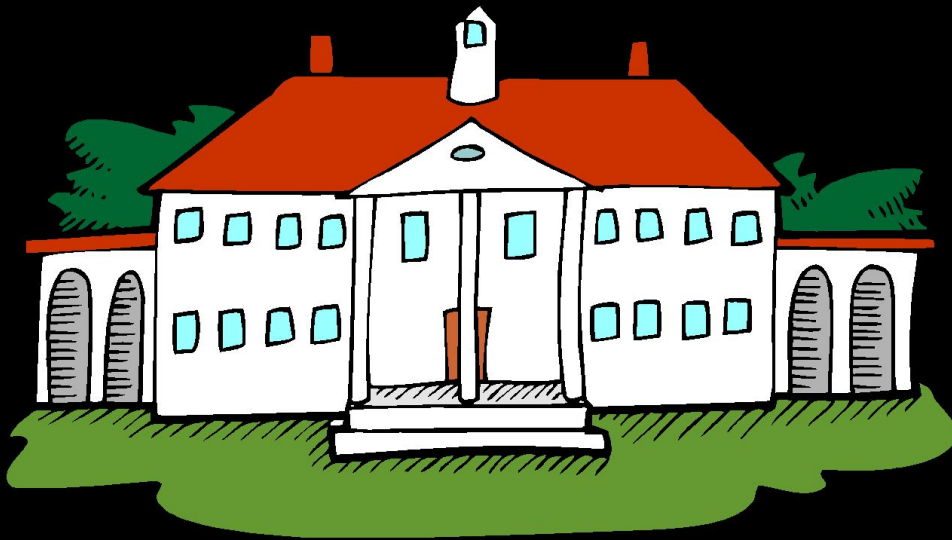
