





LOOK AT THESE ANIMALS. WHO IS LARGER: THE ELEPHANT OR THE WHALE?



IS THERE ANY ANIMAL LARGER THAN THE

WHALE?

IF WE WANT TO SAY ABOUT SOMETHING SUPERIOR IN THE GROUP, WE USE THE SUPERLATIVE.

Example: The blue whale is <u>the largest</u> animal in the world.

NOTE! We USUALLY use article 'THE' with

the superlatives.

1. Form the superlative forms of a one-syllable adjective by adding –est.

Examples:

long – <u>the</u> lon<u>gest</u> tall – <u>the</u> tall<u>est</u>

2. If the one-syllable adjective ends with

-e, just add -st for the superlative form.

an

Examples:

cute – <u>the</u> cute<u>st</u> large – <u>the</u> large<u>st</u>

3. Add –est to adjectives that end in consonant-vowel-consonant and double the last consonant. (CVC)

Examples:

big – <u>the</u> biggest hot – <u>the</u> ho<u>tt</u>est

4. With most two-syllable adjectives, you form the comparative with <u>the most</u>.

Examples:

honest – <u>the most</u> honest famous – <u>the most</u> famous

5. If the two-syllable adjectives ends with -y, change the y to i and add –est for the superlative form.

Examples:

happy – the happiest crazy – the craziest

6. Two-syllable adjectives ending in –er, –le, or –ow take –est to form the superlative forms.

Examples:

narrow – the narrowest gentle – the gentlest

7. Add <u>most</u> to adjectives that have 3 or more syllables.

Examples:

expensive – the most expensive difficult – the most difficult

8. IRREGULAR ADJECTIVES

good – the best bad – the worst far – the farthest/furthest little – the least many/much – the most
