Zemstvo government building



The building is a city building of the pre-revolutionary period.

After the Revolution, it was first occupied by the House of Political Education, and then by the House of Labor. Today, the Social Security Administration is located within its walls. The building of the Zemstvo Council is famous for its stucco molding, sandriks and mascarons.

Sterlitamak Shihan



Shihan, over 230 million years old, are high hills whose shape is conical. The highest shihan is the 402-meter shihan Tratau. At its foot are the ruins of a women's prison. The largest in area is the 357-meter shihan Kushtau. A ski slope opens here in winter. And the farthest of the Shihan is Yuraktau. It is famous for its springs. Near it lies Lake Moksha. Shihan are of interest to paragliders and for lovers of geology (tourists will be able to see the fossilized marine inhabitants).

Nur al-Iman Mosque




The cathedral mosque was opened in 2007. 700-800 believers can be accommodated there. The main dome of the mosque is surrounded by 4 green minarets. They are observation platforms. Everything inside the mosque is ascetic, and Uzbek carpets are on the floor. In the main hall they pray, celebrations and other events are held. It is located on the 1st floor. On the ground floor there is a female room, and on the 2nd floor there is a male room.

Tatiana Church



The temple was founded in 1897, after which it was closed several times, but in 1992 it was again returned to believers. Since 2002, the church has been a courtyard of the Mother of God-Tabyn Monastery. The church is a repository of icons with the relics of Tatiana, Theodore of Sanaksar, Moses, the Hermit of Barbara Skvorchikhinsky, Archimandrite of Ufa.

Victory Park



Victory Park is located in the center of Sterlitamak. Several objects on its territory deserve attention:

Samples of military equipment from the Second World War, in particular, the T-34 tank and 45-mm gun; Monument to soldiers-internationalists; Monument to the unknown soldier and the Eternal Flame next to him; Tree of love and desires; Bench of lovers.

Every year, the park becomes the venue for events dedicated to the Second World War.

Park of Culture and Rest Yuri Gagarin



The park is equipped with trampolines ("Dragon", "Mickey", "Treasure Island", etc.), family ("Journey through the Ancient World", Ferris Wheel, Autodrom, 5D-cinema, "Safari", etc.), children (" The Sun "," Bell "," Cosmos ", etc.) and extreme (" Centrifuge "," UFO "," Astronaut ", etc.) attractions. There is also a Galaxy Pavilion for entertainment devices. On Wednesdays, the park is the venue for retro parties, and on weekends cultural and entertainment events and children's master classes.

Russian Drama Theater



The theater was founded in 1946. Over more than 70 years of work, more than 600 performances based on the works of Shakespeare, Chekhov, Ostrovsky, Balzac, Bulgakov and other classics have been staged on its stage. The theater's repertoire includes Ruslan and Lyudmila, Undergrowth, Macbeth, Zoykin's Apartment, and other performances.
