- Gaby used to be overweight. But now she looks fit.
- Why did you use to collect chocolate wrappers?
- I did not use to sing in the shower.
- Our company used not to carry out corporate trainings.

be used to + Ving (иметь привычку что-то делать, что раньше не делали)

- They are used to sleeping outdoors.
- I am already used to driving on the left. It was rather hard when I first came to England.
- Tony is used to sleeping with the lights on.
- We are used to carrying out ambitious projects.
- Debora hates going to Chinese restaurants. She isn't used to eating with chopsticks.

get used to+ Ving, noun (привыкать к чемуто)
