	<i><u>If clause (condition)</u></i>	<i><u>main clause (result)</u></i>
<p><b><u>ZERO CONDITIONAL</u></b> Used for present, real/factual situations</p>	<p>If I <u>drink</u> coffee at night, (If + present tense)</p>	<p>I <u>don't sleep</u> well. (present tense)</p>
<p><b><u>FIRST CONDITIONAL</u></b> Used for future, real/factual situations</p>	<p>If I <u>drink</u> coffee tonight, (If + present tense)</p>	<p>I <u>won't sleep</u> well. (present tense)</p>
<p><b><u>SECOND CONDITIONAL</u></b> Used for present or future unreal, imaginary situations</p>	<p>If I <u>drank</u> coffee tonight, (If + past tense)</p>	<p>I <u>wouldn't sleep</u> well. (would, could, might + base form of verb)</p>
<p><b><u>THIRD CONDITIONAL</u></b> Used for past unreal, imaginary situations</p>	<p>If I <u>had drunk</u> coffee last night, (If + past perfect)</p>	<p>I <u>wouldn't have slept</u> well. (would have, could have, might have + past participle)</p>
