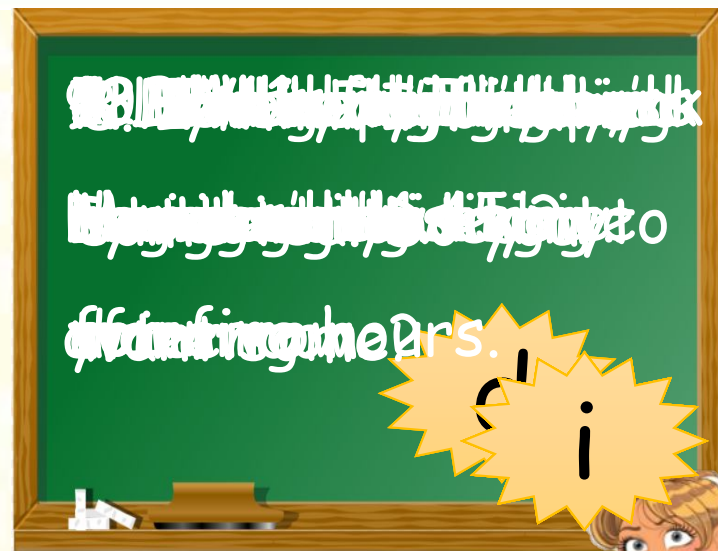

✓ *I can't wait until my studies are finished and I can travel the world.* – Я не могу ждать, пока я закончу учебу и начну путешествовать по миру.

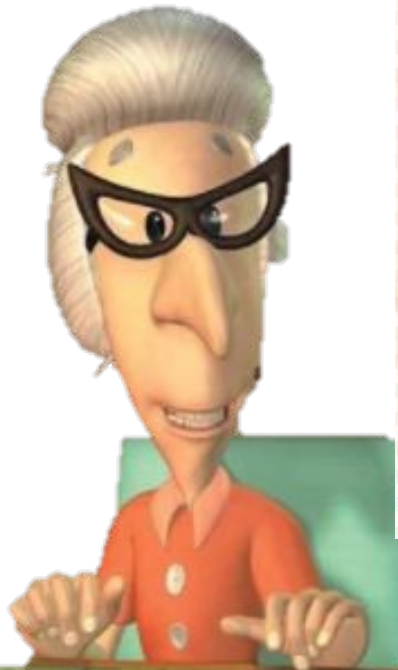
