

# Present Perfect

#### Positive Form



I/You/we/they + have (I've etc.)



He/she/it + has (He's etc.)



I've bought a new car


## **Negative Form**



I/You/we/they + have not (I haven't etc.) (I've not etc.)



He/she/it + has not (He hasn't etc.) (He's not etc.)



# \* - для правильных глаголов ( regular verbs)

Часто глаголы являются неправильными (irregular verbs). В таком случае форма прошедшего времени образуется иначе, без добавления окончания - ed. Формы неправильных глаголов необходимо запоминать.

See - seen Put- put

Go - gone

# **Present Perfect Continuous**

#### **Positive Form**



He/she/it \_\_ has been (He's been etc.)

+ Verb+ing

I/You/we/they + have been (I've been etc.)

I've been playing basketball

#### **Negative Form**




He/she/it + has not been (He's not been etc.)

+ Verb+ing

I/You/we/they + have not been (I've not been etc.)

I have not been watching TV


