It can have nationwide or local form. This may result in the adoption of a new policy or specific legislation. In some countries, it is synonymous with or commonly known by other names including a plebiscite, a referendum, popular consultation, ballot question, ballot measure, or proposition. Some definitions of plebiscite suggest it is a type of vote to change the constitution of government of a country. The word referendum is often a catchall, used for both legislative referrals and initiatives.

The last amendment to the Egyptian constitution

A referendum on constitutional amendments was held in Egypt from April 20-22, 2019. The proposed changes would allow President Abdel Fattah el-Sisi to remain in power until 2030; Which under the 2014 constitution prior to the amendment would have been barred from competing in elections scheduled for 2022
