Only 0.5% of first-year students of the Korean Medical Institute will be admitted to work in their specialty and will make a career in their chosen field.

The best universities with college the medicine in South Korea are Seoul National University and Yonsei University.

It is the best university in South Korea for studying medicine. The university includes the College of Medicine. The College has two faculties: the faculty of Basic Medical Science and the faculty of Clinical Science.
