Let's go to the bar.

How about going to the bar?

Are you busy on Friday morning?

What are you doing tomorrow\_night?

Would you like to go to the theater?

## How to arrange a meeting

- **♦Let's + bare infinitive**eg. Let's go to the bar.
- ♦ How about + gerund (V ing)
  eg. How about going to the bar?
- **♦Are you busy/free +time?** *eg.* Are you busy on Friday morning?
- **♦ What are you doing + time?** *eg.* What are you doing tomorrow night?
- Would you like+ infinitive?

**eg**. Would you like to go to the theater?

#### Positive responses

- ❖I can make it at / on...
- No problem, we can meet...
- ❖Fine with me!
- ❖Let's do it!

#### Negative response

- Sorry, I'm busy.
- Sorry, I can't make it.
- Sorry, I already have plans.

### Prepositions of time: at/on/in

AT	ON	IN
<pre>/time:   at 5 p.m / at lunchtime /other phrases:   at night / at the weekend</pre>	on Monday on Sunday morning	<pre>/months / seasons: in July, in autumn /other phrases: in the morning / afternoon / evening</pre>
