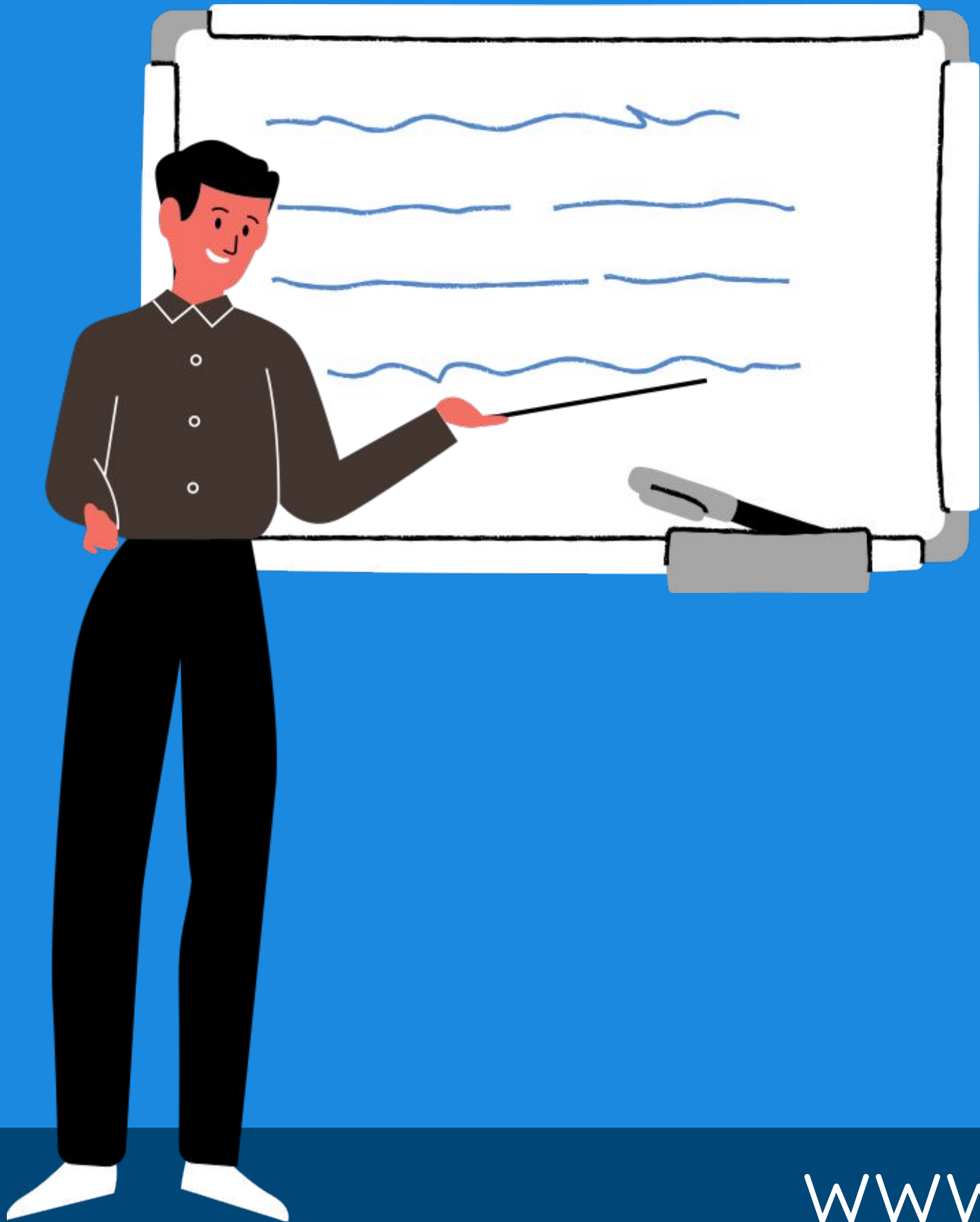

- **What Is The Second Conditional?**

Second conditional sentences are used to talk about **future** things which are **unlikely** or **impossible**.

Example:

"If I won the lottery, I would buy a big house."

2. How To Form Second Conditional Sentences

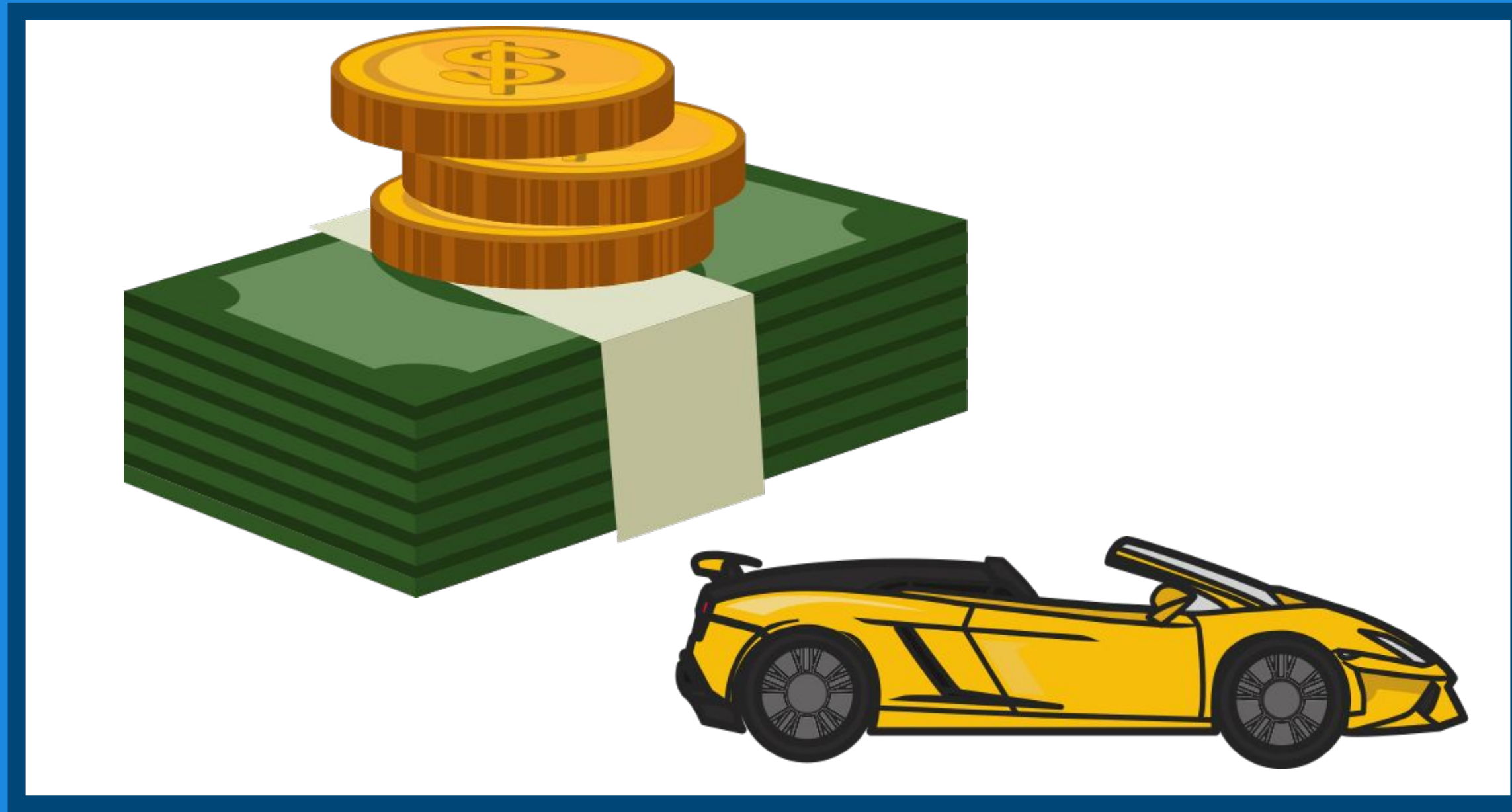
Second conditional sentences are made up of an **'if clause'** and a **'main clause'**. The 'if clause' has a verb in the **past simple** tense.

The 'main clause' has **'would' + an infinitive verb**.

Example:

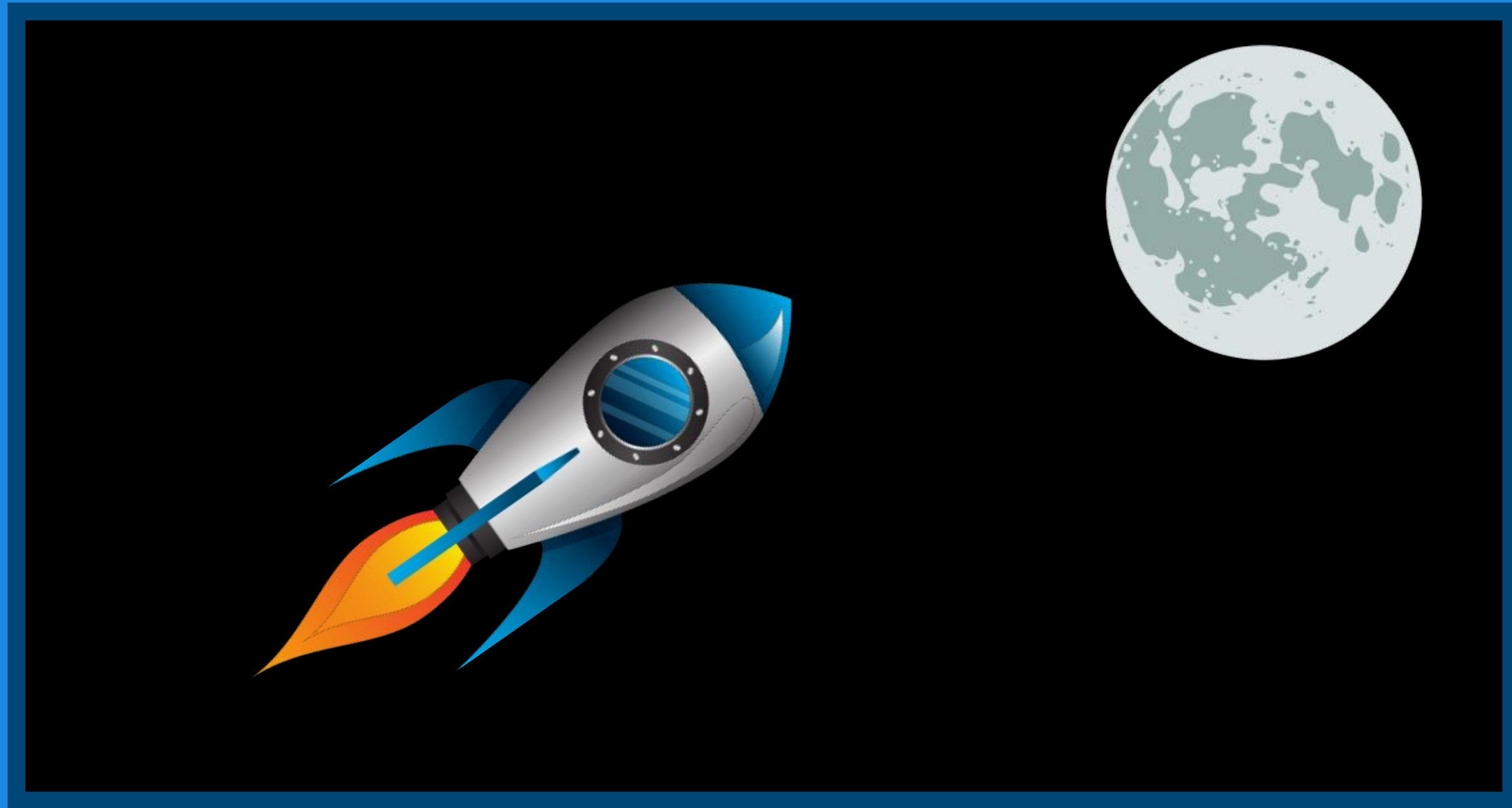
"If I **won the lottery, I **would buy** a big house."**

3. Example Sentences



If I had a million dollars, I would buy a sports car.

3. Example Sentences



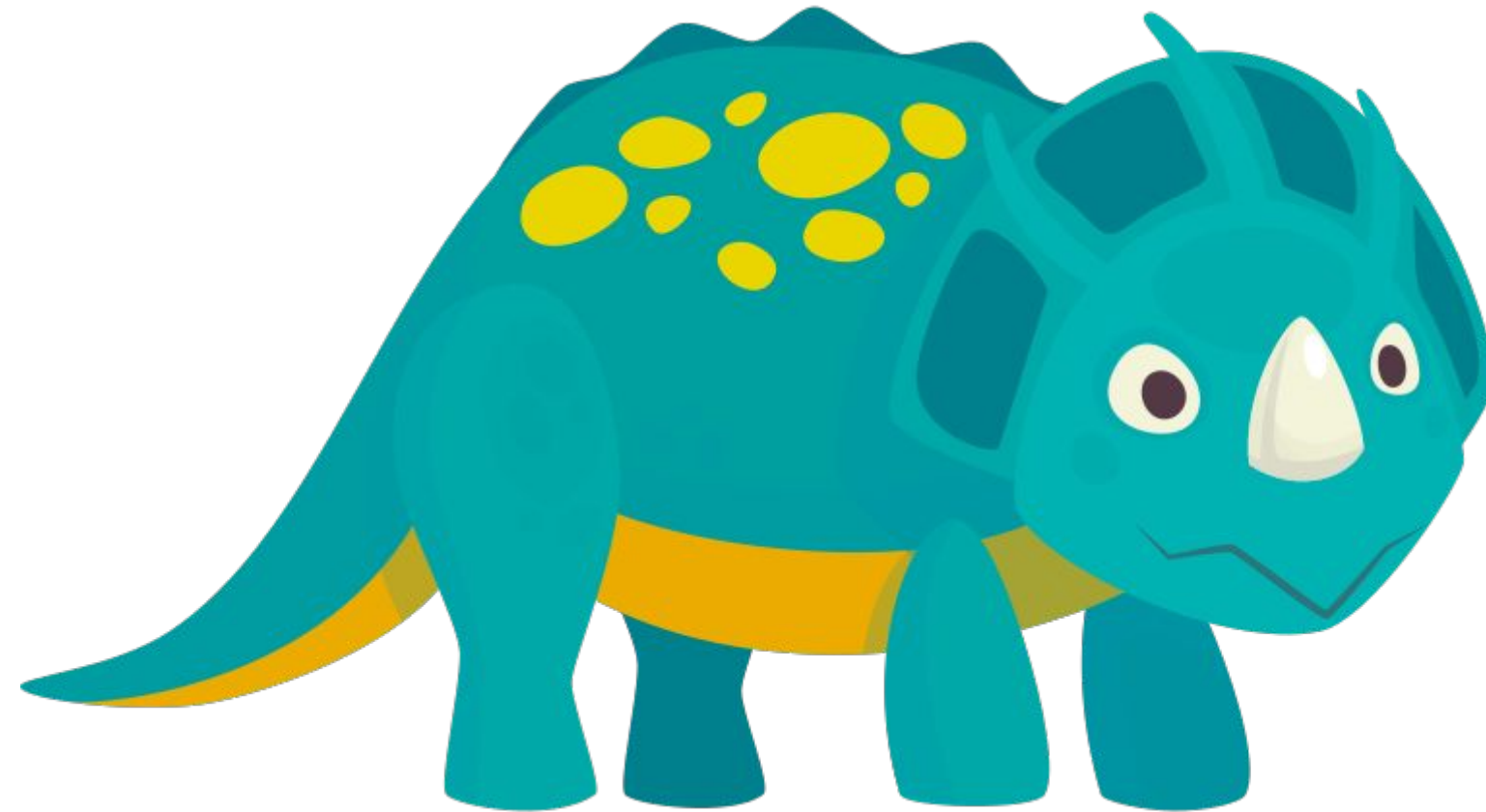
If I had a rocket, I would fly to the moon.

3. Example Sentences



If the weather wasn't so bad, I would go to the park.

3. Example Sentences



If I could travel back in time, I would have a pet dinosaur.
