

#### What Is The Second Conditional?

Second conditional sentences are used to talk about future things which are unlikely or impossible.

Example:

"If I won the lottery, I would buy a big house."

## 2. How To Form Second Conditional Sentences


Second conditional sentences are made up of an 'if clause' and a

'main clause'. The 'if clause' has a verb in the past simple tense.


The 'main clause' has 'would' + an infinitive verb.

Example:

"If I won the lottery, I would buy a big house."




If I had a million dollars, I would buy a sports car.




If I had a rocket, I would fly to the moon.




If the weather wasn't so bad, I would go to the park.



If I could travel back in time, I would have a pet dinosaur.




If I could travel anywhere, I would go to Korea.


