When we use a/an/the

Артикль **the** подчеркивает:

- уникальность предмета
- что предмет или субъект уже известен собеседникам

Артикль a/an нужен для того, чтобы

- подчеркнуть, что кто-то или что-то является «одним из» представителей своего сообщества
- ввести новую информацию, показать, что субъект или объект ранее не обсуждался и не известен собеседникам

How to tell about your experience?

PRESENT PERFECT - MEANING

PAST RECENT EVENTS

We don't say when. Or with time expressions including now.

She's had an accident. I've passed the exam.



JUST, ALREADY, YET

"Have you finished yet?" "Yes, I've already finished."

RECENTLY

Have you seen any good films recently?

TODAY, THIS WEEK, THIS MONTH, ETC.

I haven't seen Ted today. Maybe he isn't feeling well.

PAST EXPERIENCES

We don't say when these events happened.

We've been to Rome and Florence.

I haven't read that book.



NEVER, EVER, BEFORE

"Have you ever read it?" "I have never read it."

Superlative + EVER

This is the best food I've ever tried.

Number of times until now

I've seen this film three times.

UNFINISHED SITUATIONS

Situations that started in the past and have not finished.

How long have you been here? I have been here all day.



HOW LONG, FOR, SINCE

We have been married for 20 years.

ALL + time expression I've lived in this house all my life.

LATELY

We have been very busy lately.
