What nouns are uncountable?



Uncountable nouns

a carton of milk

a bowl of rice

a loaf of bread

a bottle of olive oil

a sack of flour

Some/ any

- There is **some** bread.
- There are **some** bananas.
- *There isn't **any** bread.*
- *There aren't **any** bananas.*
 - *Is there **any** bread?*
 - *Are there **any** bananas?*

We use **some** in the affirmative.

We use **any** in the negative and interrogative.
