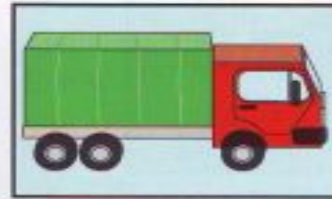

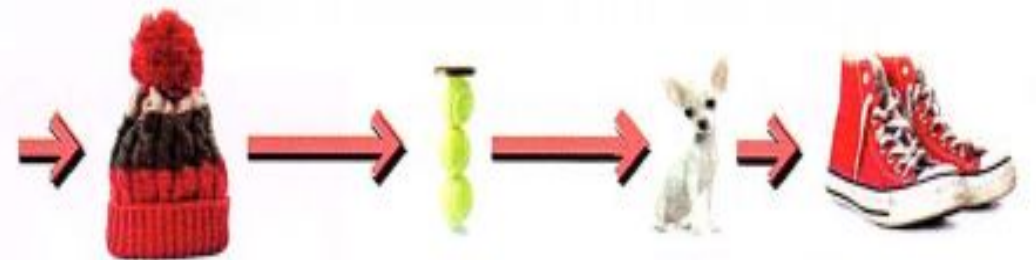

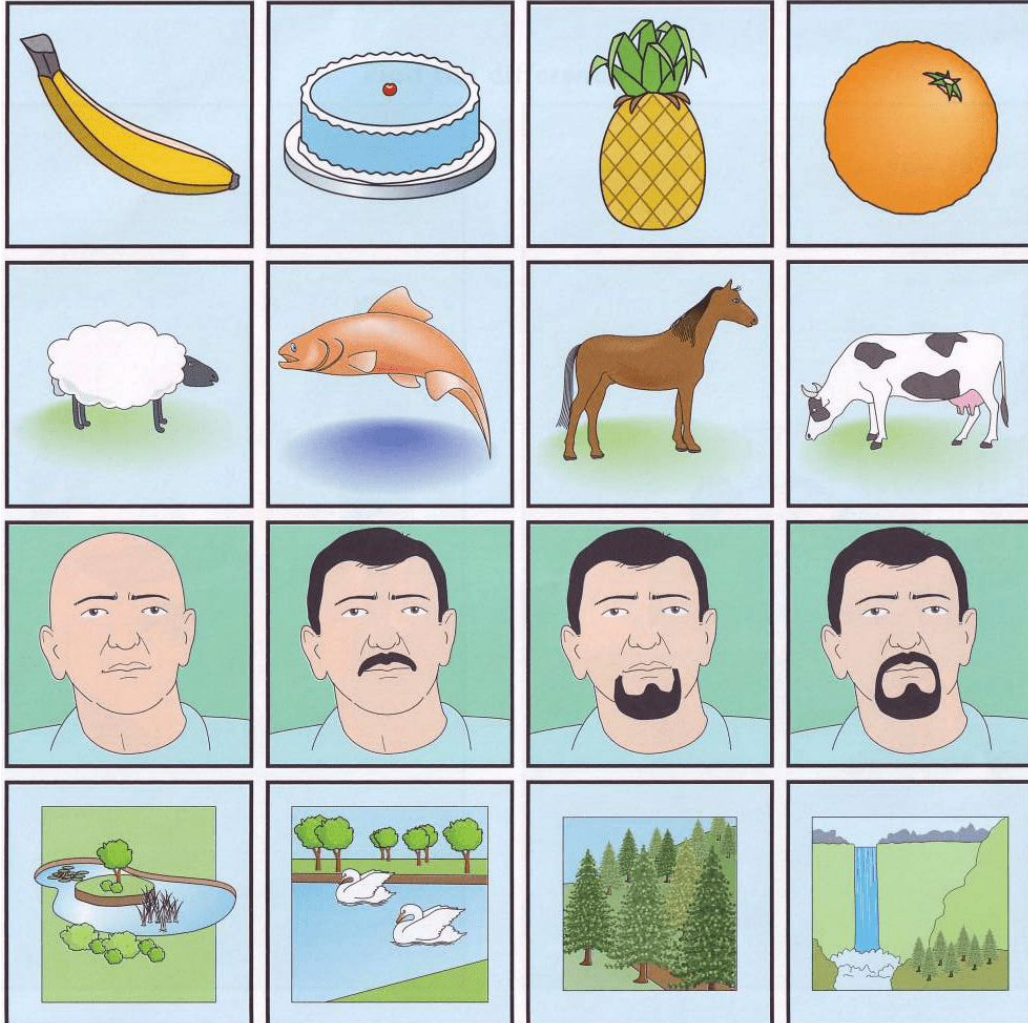
Extra activity
